PREPARATION ADVICE (for 2 Liters)

De Heus Nurse Meal is a premium feed, carefully prepared with high value nutrients, specifically designed for the youngest category of piglets. Therefore, homogeneous mixing and clean conditions are essential, with water quality and temperature playing a crucial role. Follow the preparation instructions to ensure optimal results:

- **1.** Boil 1,5 liter of water, leave 750 ml. for the next feeding in a closed bottle / bucket / jerrycan.
- **2.** Mix 750 ml. hot water with 750 ml. water from previous feeding.
- **3.** Dose 500 ml. of powder on top 1,5 liter of mixed water (55°C).
- **4.** Mix powder and water for minimal 2 minutes, let it soak for 20 minutes and then mix it again for 2 minutes.
- **5.** Close bags after usage, store dry and in the shadow.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS:

- When prepared under clean conditions the shelf life is 12 hours.
- Clean the throughs minimum 4 times per day.
- Feed minimum 4 times per day (also for dry feed), preferable 8 times per day.
- 1 hour after feeding the piglets must have finished the feed (otherwise limit the dose next feeding).

OPTIMISING EARLY NUTRITION WITH DE HEUS NURSE MEAL

To support optimal growth and vitality in young piglets, De Heus Nurse Meal is designed to be offered as a liquid when used as a replacement for sow's milk—ensuring maximum intake. When used as a supplement alongside sow's milk, it can be provided either dry or liquid. The guidelines below serve as a practical reference for both approaches. In all cases, ad libitum feeding is recommended to encourage natural intake and support uniform development.
